Dear Parents/Carers.

What a busy start to the second half of the autumn term, and it's only going to get busier! We have lots of opportunities coming up for you to visit school over the next few weeks so please check out all of the dates below.

### **Puffin Patrollers**

The Puffin Patrollers have been very busy! They helped to sort and pack the mountain of donations made at the Harvest festival before they could be delivered to Amble Food Bank, (please see the letter of thanks attached). They have completed work on safeguarding and they are currently exploring how we can make our behaviour even better around school!

## Reading Leaders

Our Reading Leaders have started to support our younger children with their reading. Reading Leads have been going into Reception, Year 1 and Year 2 in the mornings during reading time to listen to children read which is having a great impact on reading across school. Reading Leads are also monitoring our Read to Lead challenge where we challenge children to read at least four times over one week, (not four times a night!). Research suggests that reading daily has a massive impact on a child's development. Reading Leads will also be issuing Reading certificates in our Celebration assembly.

#### Book Fair

Scholastic book fair will be in school from **Monday 18th to Friday 22nd November**. You will be able to visit the fair every night straight after school. This could be a great opportunity to buy some Christmas presents! There is a cashless payment system in place, so you only need your phone and card details to place your order.

#### Maths

Number Confidence drop ins have already started to happen this week in school. The drop ins are an opportunity for families to join their child in exploring fun ways to use Maths in everyday situations e.g. cooking, shopping, banking etc. Please see the dates below for your child's drop in.
